My passion for evaluating livestock and teaching youth is why I like the judging arena.

For the past ten years I lived in Torrington, WY where I evaluated feedlot cattle on a daily basis to achieve the highest market return for my customers' cattle to the packer. In 2012 I marketed over 370,000 head of cattle for Consolidated Beef Producers. While in Torrington, WY I coached the Goshen County 4-H livestock judging team for five years and was fortunate enough to have three state winning senior teams and five state winning junior teams. I carried two teams to the American Royal and two teams to the N.A.I.L.E where we have had successful runs, including winning the beef division at the American Royal in 2011.

I was raised in Okeechobee, FL and showed livestock throughout the state focusing primarily on cattle but also showing swine and sheep. Upon completion of high school and finishing my duties of being a Florida State FFA officer in 1995-96, I moved to Clarendon, TX to pursue livestock judging and an education in agriculture. I was a member of a very successful team at Clarendon College under the tutelage of the late Jerry Hawkins then continued my education and livestock judging career at Oklahoma State University under Dr. Mark Z. Johnson fulfilling a knowledgeable career at OSU.

I moved back to south Florida (Sebring) in May 2013 where I am involved in real estate, merchandising feeder cattle and working with my brother in starting a herd to produce quality show cattle focusing on American breed crosses.
