

**Florida 4-H Horse Program's  
ELAINE KEIR MEMORIAL OUTSTANDING VOLUNTEER  
LEADERSHIP AWARD**



**Who:** Florida 4-H Adult Horse Leader of the Year

**What:** An annual award to recognize individuals who work with youth and horses within the Florida 4-H program. This top leader introduces newcomers to the horse industry, mentors young horsemen, and promotes 4-H and the horse industry within the local community. They accomplish these goals in fun and innovative ways. Any member, leader, or agent may nominate a deserving adult leader from the Florida 4-H Horse Program. The nominee should be considered a good ambassador of the youth horse industry and Florida 4-H Horse Programs for this state recognition.

**When:** Nominations from counties should be sent to your Area Youth 4H Horse Program Coordinator (<http://animal.ifas.ufl.edu/youth/HorseAdvisory/Documents/Board%20Members.pdf>) by June 2<sup>nd</sup>. Area horse committees must review nominations and select the Area nominee. Area nominee packets must be submitted to Wendy DeVito by June 9<sup>th</sup>, 2017.

**Why:** Strong adult leadership for young horsemen today helps ensure a vital horse industry in the future. Any leader who volunteers time and effort to the Florida 4-H Horse Programs and youth horse industry should be recognized as a potential candidate for this award.

**Nomination Requirements:**

- Electronically submit a completed nomination form
  - Include 3 photos illustrating the nominee's involvement in horse and/or leadership activities.
- Photos must be jpeg format and at least 300 dpi.
- Submission should be formatted in 12 point Arial font, single spaced (hand written applications will not be accepted).
- Attach a minimum of 2 letters of recommendation/support. (maximum of 5 letters)
  - At least one of these letters must be from a youth
- Letter writers may not be related to the nominee

**Selection process:**

- A committee will review and evaluate the Nominees then select this year's recipient based on the following criteria:
  - The nominee's leadership in the horse industry
  - The nominee's specific contributions to the youth horse industry through Florida 4-H
  - The nominee's "level" of involvement (local, statewide or beyond)
- Nominees will be recognized at the Florida 4-H State Horse Show Awards Program.
- The award winner will be recognized at the Florida 4-H State Horse Show's Saturday night awards program in Tampa, FL and their application will be forwarded to AYHC for National consideration.

**Nominations not meeting the above requirements will not be considered**
